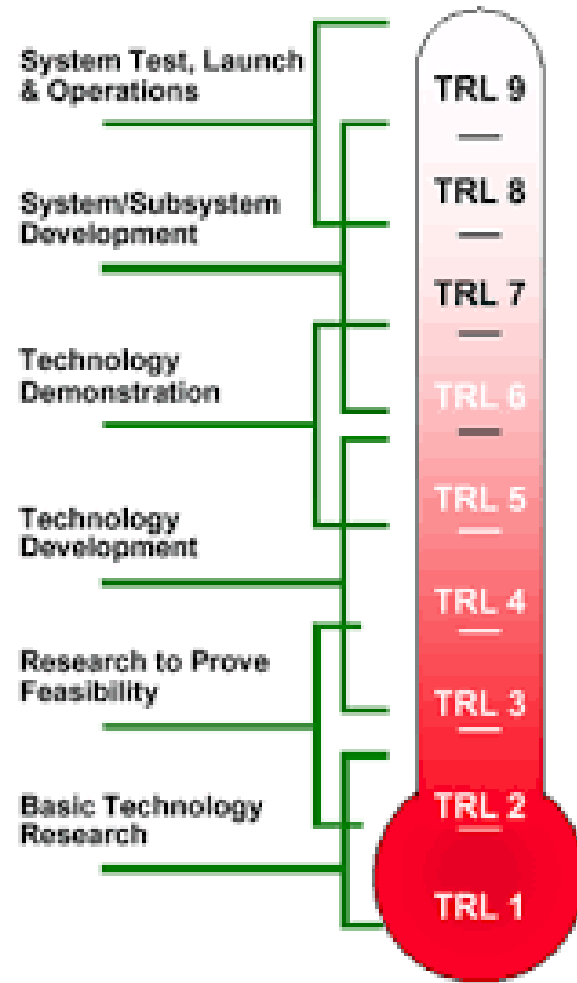

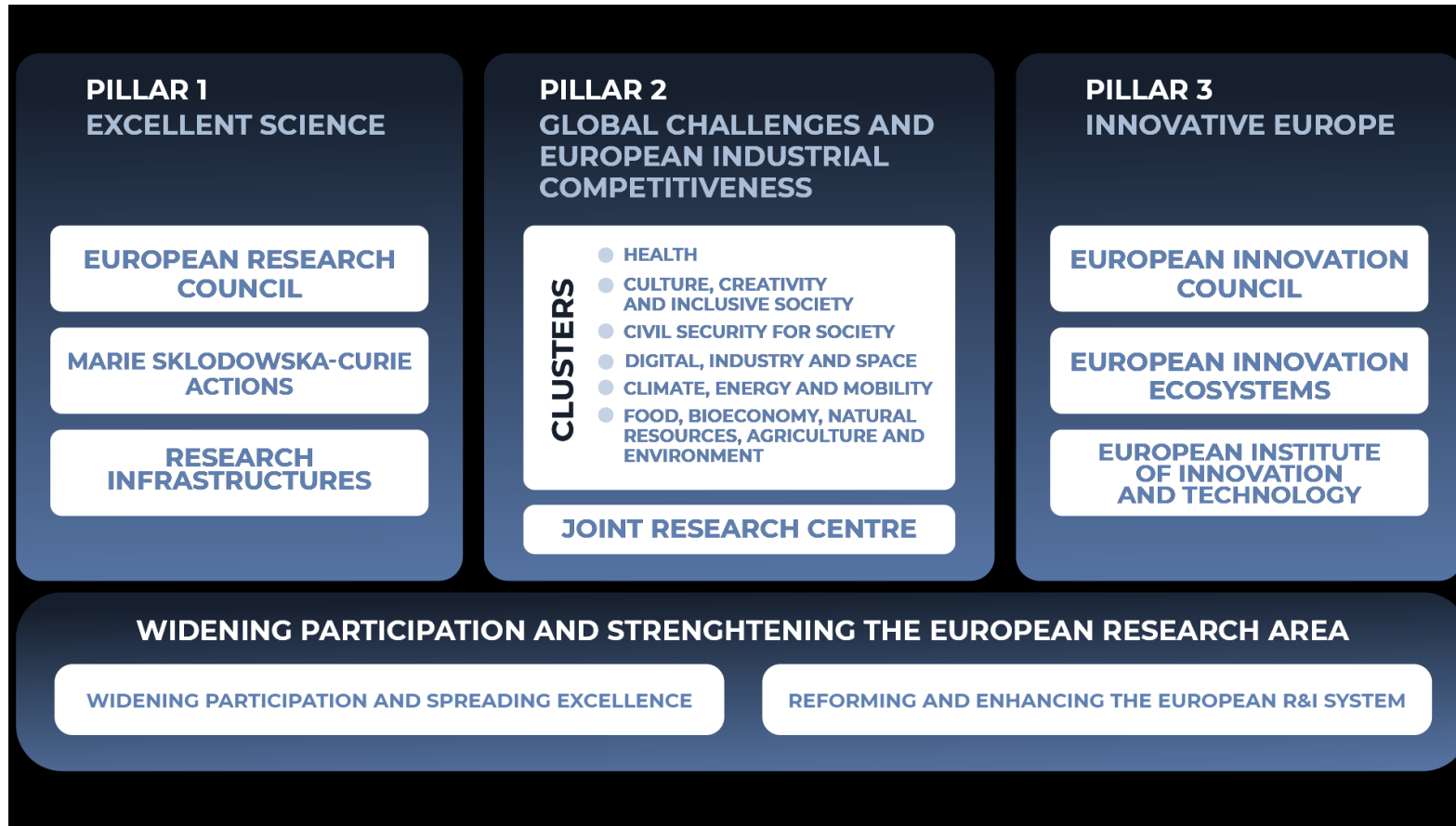
- 
- **The main program to fund Research and Innovation (2021/2027) – 100 billions euros**
 - **Funding often collaborative projects** : minimum 2 or 3 partners . **Some exceptions for mobility grants (Marie S Curie Program), accelerator program for disruptive SMEs,...**
 - **Funding transitional projects** : partners are coming from minimum **2** or **3** Eligible countries (EU or associated countries, depending the program).
 - A H Europe project is often a project that mixes **stakeholders from Universities, technical centres, industries, local authorities that will work together to achieve production of knowledge and/or development of innovative products, processes or services.**
 - Funding : Grant between 70% and 100% of the eligible costs depending on the type of partners and actions

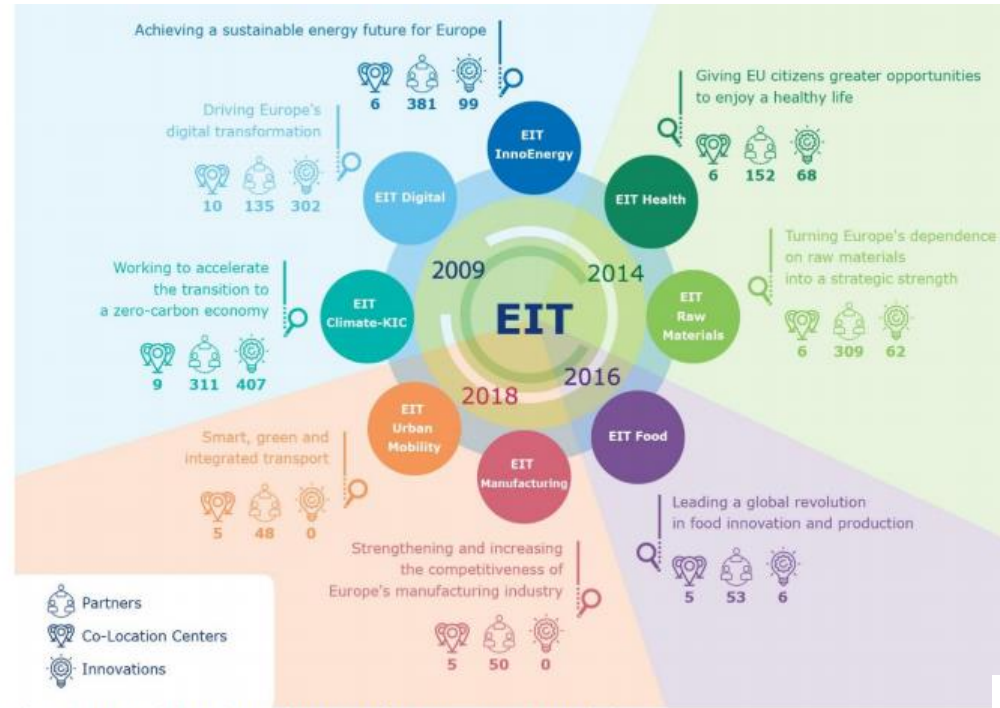


Figure 2: EIT Knowledge and Innovation Communities, source: European Commission
